## Our Services

### OUR SERVICES

The clinical research floor consists of a main open plan foyer/waiting room and reception area, a number of clinical/ medical consulting rooms, and one boardroom. Overall, Level 3 would suit a variety of different medically related research users.

#### The medical and consulting rooms

- Located behind the main reception area of level 3.
- Average size of the consulting rooms range from 12.6 to 13.4 square metres.
- Each suit consists of a desk space, examination bed and a single sink.
- All clinical rooms are equipped with UQ/QH IT support and

basic items such as gloves, sharps bins, (including request forms for Pathology and Radiology investigation).

- Housed within the clinical floor is a small instrument sterilisation room and a sluice room.

### BOOKING

- Each clinical medical rooms can be booked on a per session basis;  
Morning session: 8am-12noon  
Afternoon session: 1pm-5pm
- Rooms can also be booked on a regular cycle or for exclusive use.
- All users have access to the shared facilities such as the patient waiting room and reception.

### FEES

UQCCR places no restriction on the number of patients that can be seen in a session; the same fixed fee will apply. This can be invoiced on a session-by-session basis or in advance, or as agreed with the Clinical Coordinator.
